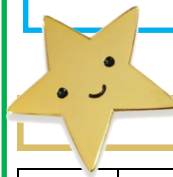

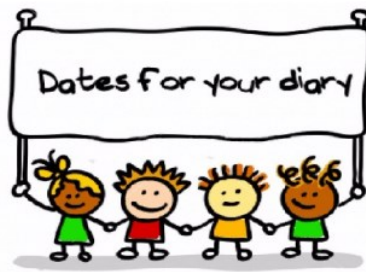

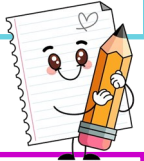
DINNER MONEY
