Have a wonderful weekend everyone, here's hoping the sunshine continues.

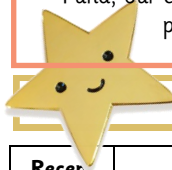
## Valuable items and cash in school

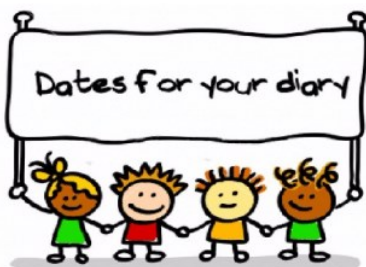
